Ballot Issues for April 4th, 2006

Proposition EJ (vote Yes of **No, Simple
Majority Required):** Shall the Board of Trustees
of St. Louis Community College (Junior College
District of St. Louis, St. Louis County, Missouri)
be authorized to increase the operating tax levy
for the purposes of implementing
recommendations from the GROWTH community
engagement process which includes implementing
job-training programs, improving instructional
programs, enhancing instructional staff, providing
necessary computer and technology infrastructure,
repairing and replacing roofs, modernizing and
replacing heating and cooling systems, improving
safety and security operations, and constructing
and equipping new instructional facilities by \$0.12
cents per one hundred dollars of assessed
valuation? If this proposition is approved, the
adjusted operating levy of the college district is
estimated to be \$0.3408 cents per one hundred
dollars of assessed valuation.

Required):** Shall the Board of Directors of the Mid
County Fire Protection District of St. Louis County be
authorized to levy an additional tax of not more than
fifty cents (\$.50) on the one hundred dollar (\$100.00)
assessed valuation to provide funds for the support of
the district?
