### PROPOSITION M:

**SIMPLE MAJORITY REQUIRED**  
**Vote YES or NO**

Shall the County of St. Louis impose, in addition to an existing County-wide sales tax of one-quarter of one percent for the same purpose, a county-wide sales tax of one-half of one percent (0.50%) which shall have a sunset date twenty years from the date on which the tax is first imposed, for the purpose of providing a source of funds for public transportation purposes, with the revenues from one-quarter of one percent (0.25%) to be used for expansion of a light rail system and revenues from the remaining one-quarter of one percent (0.25%) to be used for the maintenance of existing public transit facilities?

**PROPOSITION M**  
**Removed from Ballot**
